# JUNIOR BASS TOURNAMENT TRAIL

## Rules and Regulations

1. Anglers must compete from a boat.
2. All participants must be accompanied in the boat by an adult 18 or older (no participation fee).
3. Each boat MUST carry U.S. Coast Guard-approved safety equipment.
4. Adults will not be permitted to fish.
5. Electric trolling motors only during competition.
6. Artificial lures only. No live bait.
7. Five fish daily bag limit.
8. Minimum fish length 12 inches.
9. One-pound deduction for short fish brought to the scale.
10. All fish to be released alive.
11. Two-ounce dead fish penalty.
12. Fishing times are safe light until 1 p.m. at all sites.
13. Weigh-in time is 1 p.m. or earlier. Fish must be on the scale by 1 p.m. to avoid disqualification, unless another competitor is weighing fish.
14. Anglers allowed only one rod in the water at any given time.
15. All participants must check in with the tournament director prior to each tournament start and must launch from one predesignated location in each park.
16. Decisions of the tournament director are final.
